The above Order made on the 3 June 2021 if confirmed as made will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding:

- a) a public footpath in the parish of Skirlaugh some 57 metres in length commencing on Poplar Close at Grid Reference TA 1416 3960 (Point A on the Map) and leads south-south-easterly to join Church Lane (B1243) at Grid Reference TA 1419 3955 (Point B on the Map). The footpath will have a width of 1.74 metres (A-E) and 2.4 metres (E-B), and
- b) a public footpath in the parish of Skirlaugh some 91 metres in length commencing on Main Road at Grid Reference TA 1412 3956 (Point C on the Map) and leads east-north-easterly to join Church Lane (B1243) at Grid Reference TA 1421 3959 (Point D on the Map). The footpath will have a width of 3.0 metres.

Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order or if any so made are withdrawn, The East Riding of Yorkshire Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment any representations or objections which have been duly made and not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
